Important Information for Seniors

The college application season is in full swing. There are a number of steps in the process and our School Counselors have been reaching out to their Seniors for meetings to review their plans for the future and assist them in navigating their way through the process. Here is a brief overview of the steps:

- Step 1 – Make an appt. with your Counselor.
- Step 2 – Request your letters of recommendation from teachers.
- Step 3 – Create a Common Application account.
- Step 4 – Complete FAFSA Opened on October 1st.
