# Monosnap: ScreenCaps & Sharing

Monosnap is perfect tool that allows you to take, share and manage your screenshots.

- Capture full screen, just part of the screen, or a selected window.
- Highlight important details with pen, text, arrows and shapes.
- Hide private information with our blur tool.
- Login to get free cloud storage space.
- Upload your snapshot to our storage in one click.
- Or save it to your local folder and copy it to clipboard.



This program has endless possibilities for classroom use—especially as we are moving toward wifi and online learning. You can create online instructions, annotations, etc. It can be installed on a computer, iPad, iPhone, or as an extension of the Chrome Browser.

I used it to make the

screen image of the new website on the first page of this newsletter!

Students could also use it to mark text by boxing or circling online text and send it to you! It can be uploaded to an online account, or saved to you computer/device.
